<u>Weekly</u>	<u>Provides:</u>
\$1.00	Two nights lodging for a homeless person through <u>The Salvation Army.</u>
\$1.00	One hour of physical, occupational, or speech therapy for a child with a disability at the <u>Special Learning Center.</u>
\$1.00	One month of afterschool care for a school age child at the <u>Boys and Girls Club of the Capital City.</u>
\$2.00	One pair of shoes for two school aged children through <u>Dental, Eye, and Shoe.</u>
\$2.00	A buddy pack for one student for an entire school year through <u>The Food Bank for Central & Northeast Missouri.</u>
\$4.00	13 hours of in-home services for the elderly and disable from <u>Homemaker Health Care.</u>
\$5.00	Transportation to the <u>Special Learning Center</u> for one child for an entire school year.
\$10.00	15 nights stay for adults and children affected by domestic violence through <u>Rape & Abuse Crisis Service.</u>
\$10.00	2 hours of transportation a day for one client through <u>Osage County Community Living.</u>
\$10.00	A nutritious meal for 80 of our community's homebound elderly through <u>Senior Nutrition Center.</u>
\$20.00	8 weeks of daycare for infants and toddlers through <u>Jefferson City Day Care Center.</u>
