

2016 United Way of Central Missouri Facts

- 91 cents of every dollar donated goes directly to services.
- 28 partner agencies, programs and initiatives
 - Two new agencies added in 2015
 - Capital City CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates)
 - Central Missouri Foster Care & Adoption Association
- \$75,000 in one-time grants to 13 agencies (7 partner and 6 non-partner agencies)
- \$634,500 educating youth & adults 47%
- \$400,860 responding to crisis 30%
- \$260,000 improving health 19%
- \$46,116 promoting self-sufficiency 3%
- United Way partner agencies served 88,941 people in UWCEMO area (Cole, Osage, Miller, Moniteau, southern Callaway, Camden & Morgan counties).
- 72,042 or 81% people served by United Way partner agencies in 2015 are below 150% of poverty.
