



\$1 a day - \$365 provides:

- 5475 pounds of food to hungry families through The Food Bank.
- 189 youth participation in 4-H programs to develop skills that benefit them throughout life.
- 146 Merit Badges that teach Scouts numerous life skills through the Boy Scouts.
- 135 home bound meals to seniors through Senior Nutrition Council.
- 122 Comfort Kits to children and adults affected by house fires or other disasters through the American Red Cross Heart of Missouri Chapter.
- Transportation for 24 round trips for individuals with disabilities through Osage County Community Living.
- 52 trips on the Special Learning Center bus for a special needs child to and from school to receive the needed therapy.
- 63 hours of wages paid to 1 employee with a disability working at Capitol Projects, Sheltered Workshop.
- 24 girls with membership assistance to participate in the Girl Scout Leadership Experience.
- 15 books used by ABLE tutors to help their students develop literacy skills and achieve their goals.
- 14 nights lodging for a homeless person at The Salvation Army's Center of Hope Emergency Shelter.
- 12 nights stay for adults and children affected by domestic violence through Rape & Abuse Crisis Service.
- 7 children a week's worth of summer camp activities through Tri-County YMCA.
- 6 sessions of mental health services through Pathways Community Health.
- 5 prescription medications to an uninsured patient through the Community Health Center of Central Missouri.
- 5 hours of OT, PT, or Speech therapy to help a child's development through the Special Learning Center.
- 4 women in need with appropriate interview and work attire to be confident and ready for work through services provided by Dreams to Reality.
- 2 students a Buddy Pack for an entire school year.

- 2 patients in need of emergency dental services provided by the Community Health Center.
- 1 child with a full semester of after school care including a daily hot, nutritious meal, homework help and life changing character development programs at Boys & Girls Club.
- 1 month of full-time childcare for a 3 yr. old through Jefferson City Day Care Center or the YMCA Child Development Center.
